

### Lesson 80: Exceptions to Murmur Diphthongs

**Silent E:** If a silent e is next to a Murmur Diphthong in a word, the silent e rules (cūrę). Do not mark the Murmur Diphthong. Prove and read these words containing silent e.

Crazy W: When w comes before a in a word, the a has the sound of short o (wgnd).



**w+ar:** When w is next to the Murmur Diphthong ar in a word, the ar says /or/ (warn). Prove and read these words containing w and the ar Murmur Diphthong.



**w+or:** When w is next to the Murmur Diphthong or in a word, the or says /er/ (work). Prove and read these words containing w and the or Murmur Diphthong.
