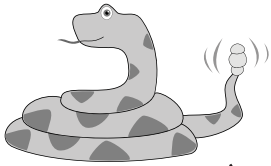

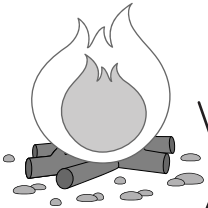
Phonetic Skill 4: The final vowel e is silent, making the first vowel long.

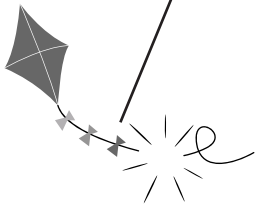

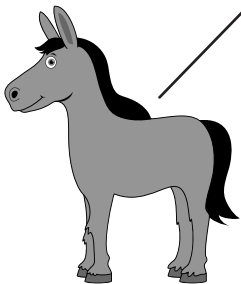

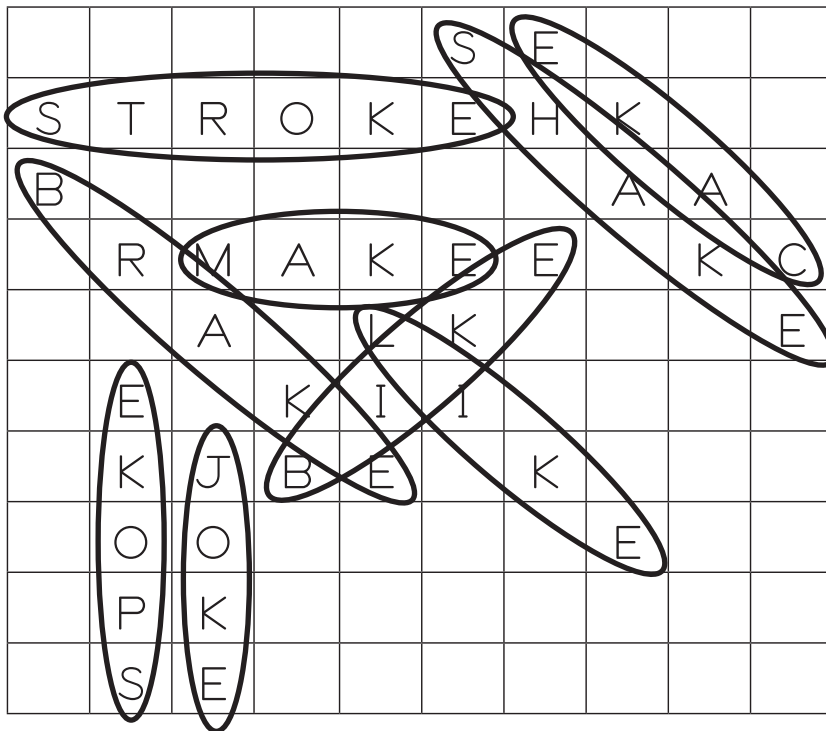
