

Write a whole row of each letter e matching the example at the beginning of each row. Read and write each slide and word one time. Remember to draw the slide arrow beneath each slide.









This activity provides practice reading and writing slides and words using the vowels *a* and *e* and previously taught consonants.



Read the slide and word in each box. Then write the word in the space provided. Mark the vowel with an x. Then read each word again. The first one has been done for you.












Find and circle each letter that is the same as the letter written on the line. Write a whole row of that letter. Say its name and sound as you write it. The first row is done for you.
